Memorial day in honor of Founding of the Republic of China	January 1 January 2	Sunday Monday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As it falls on Sunday, January 2 (Monday) should be the day off to make it up.
Lunar New Year's Eve	January 27	Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Spring Festival	January 28 January 29 January 30	Saturday Sunday Monday	Three days off from January 28 to 30 in accordance with established rules.

	January 31 February 1	Tuesday Wednesd ay	As two days of Spring Festival fall on Saturday and Sunday, January 31 (Tuesday) and February 1 (Wednesday) should be the day off to make it up.
Peace Memorial Day	February 27 February 28	Monday Tuesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. February 27 (Monday) adjusts to holiday; February 18 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Children's Day Tomb-sweeping Day	April 3 April 4	Monday Tuesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As Children's Day and Tomb-sweeping Day fall on the same day and also on Tuesday, April 3 (Monday) should be the day off.
Labor Day	May 1	Monday	One day off in accordance

			with the established rules.
Dragon Boat Festival	May 29 May 30	Monday Tuesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. May 29 (Monday) adjusts to holiday; June 3 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Mid-autumn Festival	October 4	Wednesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
National (Double Tenth) Day	October 9 October 10	Monday Tuesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. October 9 (Monday) adjusts to holiday; September 30 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
